for Athlone Marina

Thoughtlessness and a lack of understanding can cause untold damage and spoil the area for everyone.

Please follow the **'Athlone Marina Code'** to ensure an enjoyable stay for everyone

- Help us to protect the natural environment and the landscape surrounding the marina, for you and others to enjoy
- Please do not interfere with or damage any water safety equipment - this may be needed to help save lives
- Please do not empty your litter bins or toilet tank waste into the Marina – use the facilities provided
- Please use the waste recycling facilities
- Please ask at reception for details on facilities for hazardous waste: waste engine oil, lead acid batteries and fluorescent lamps
- Guard against all risk of fire and please do not light fires. Fireworks are also prohibited
- Please do not damage or interfere with fencing, tables, seating and signs
- Dogs must be kept on a lead. Owners must clean up after them. Poop scoops are available to all pet owners free of charge from the reception area
- In the interest of public safety and for the protection of the area, cycling is prohibited
- In the interest of public safety swimming is not allowed
- The Marina is not to be used for boat repairing, washing or painting
- Berthing only in the designated areas
